

Statistics show that one in four women, and one in seven men, have been the victims of severe physical violence by an "intimate partner" (boyfriend/girlfriend or spouse) at some point in their life. Nearly half of all men and women have experienced psychological aggression by an intimate partner.

Three in ten women murdered in the U.S. are murdered by their husbands, ex-husbands or boyfriends. Survey of 6,000 American families found that half of the men who assault their wives, also abuse their children. Each year an estimated 3,300,000 children are exposed to violence against their mothers or female caretakers by family members.
